## This is my answer:

My intention is for people to 'see' what I have seen and enable them to think differently, perhaps shift their perception and maybe even affect their cognition.

I seek emancipation from the tyranny of monoculturalism (colonialism, misogyny). To liberate ecosystems and all who inhabit them (human and other than human) from oppression.

My expectation is that occasionally someone will 'get it' and that maybe they too will do something about it.

This is the art of Trickster and this is my gift to those who encounter and maybe engage with my work.
