In 1998 I co-founded a research group, 'Water and Wellbeing', that brought water to arts in healthcare and placed water at the centre of ecology, climate chaos and biodiversity. Twenty-three years later, my practice is still going with the flow...

E. C. Pielou wrote in her book, *Freshwater*: 'Living things depend on water but water does not depend on living things. It has a life of its own.'
